Local Option Art Awards
\$1,000 First Prize**

In celebration of the "Junction City" Centennial, the West Toronto Junction Historical Society in association with Junction Business Improvement Association is offering a unique call to the artists.

The Junction has always represented a marriage of business and the arts and remains a bastion of the independent spirit.

We are offering a series of awards to artists who can capture a Junction theme in paintings, photographs or sculpture. The awards are open to artists of all ages. For information about the Junction go to wtjhs.ca.

Mariposa County artist Michael Reeves, through his representatives at Latitude 44 Gallery has offered awards in the amounts of:
First prize: \$1000-, Second prize: \$500- and Third prize: \$250-.

The winning entries will be chosen by public vote April 15th - September 14th 2008. The number of entrees will be determined by space available in local businesses. Picture submissions to be no larger than 3' by 5' (92 cm by 152 cm), sculptures no larger than 2' by 2' (61 cm by 61 cm).

The Institute of Canadian Popular Culture has commissioned Junction artist Reid English to create an original work, "Spirit of the Junction" which will be awarded to a member of the voting public.
