

LOCAL OPTION ART AWARDS ARTIST SUBMISSION FORM

This project is an initiative of the West Toronto Junction Historical Society Centennial Committee in partnership and the Junction Business Improvement Association.

We are making a call for artists to contribute original works of art with a Junction theme. Entries will be exhibited in participating Junction storefronts and winners chosen by the community who will have the opportunity to vote between April 14th and Sept 14, (the last day of the Junction Arts Festival.) The works and ballot boxes will be displayed in local businesses in the Junction throughout the summer, giving members of the public an opportunity to choose the first, second and third prize winners. This opportunity renews links between the arts and business communities and the general public: direct democracy in action.

Mariposa County artist Michael Reeves, through his representatives at Latitude 44, has generously donated \$1000- first prize, \$500- second prize and \$250- third prize. Businesses will choose the pieces they wish to show.

This competition is open to all ages; the works are to represent a Junction theme.

The number of entrees will be determined by space available in local businesses. Picture submissions to be no larger than 3' by 5' (92 cm by 152 cm), sculptures no larger than 2' by 2' (61 cm by 61 cm).
